As a geologist and teacher, I started taking photographs so that I could show examples of geologic concepts to my students. Soon I was intent on improving the technical and aesthetic aspects of my photographs, and the creation of a memorable image became my goal. Not surprisingly, I am drawn to photograph the landscape. Since form, light, and color define the urban environment as well as the natural, my work also includes the human-influenced landscape. My photographs capture the details, colors, and shapes of a small section of a scene that represents the whole. Details create memories.

While I enjoy the color available with visible light, I also use the alternative light available in night scenes and in the infrared section of the spectrum. These three sources of light are tools that I can use to direct the focus within the photograph.
